Please note: the Port of Piraeus is about a 20-minute drive from central Athens – and traffic can be chaotic!




The Acropolis: The ritual and ceremonial center of Ancient Athens, no visit to the city is complete without touring around this world famous location. Come with a guided tour (or a great guidebook) to make sure you see it in all its splendor.



Athens Central Market: Foodie Alert! Head to #42 Athinas to discover the true culinary heart of Athens. In operation for 150 years, here's where you'll find the true taste of Greece. Come early and stroll the aisles next to throngs of locals, then stay for lunch.



**The Ancient Agora:** The Agora was the city's marketplace — the hub of commercial, political and social life. Stroll around the site and get a true feel for ancient Greek daily life.



Lycabettus Hill: Come here to catch the sunset, or get an amazing view of Athens all the way to the sea. Lycabettus is Athens' highest point. Take a taxi up or the funicular, and make sure to visit the whitewashed church of Agios Georgios.
